


The Table Mountain massif holds centre stage in this cosmopolitan city that offers limitless opportunities for tourists to explore history, culture, nature, incredible vistas and delectable food. The Cape Grace hotel will be the base from which to explore the city, surrounds and wine country with an expert local guide on daily tours tailored to suit individual needs. Cape Town highlights include: a drive down the beautiful Atlantic seaboard and along the spectacular Chapman's Peak, get up close to African penguins at the Boulders Beach colony, visit the Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens, Cape Castle of Good Hope, or the District Six Museum, take a revolving cable-car to the top of Table Mountain, or visit the seaside town of Hermanus, reputed to be one of the best land-based whale-watching venues in the world.

### Franschhoek – Mont Rochelle – 3 Nights



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#### Franschhoek

Nestled between towering fold mountains in the beautiful Cape winelands lies the magnificent Franschhoek Valley. This is the food and wine heartland of the country, where splendid wines are grown and top chefs create international cuisine. Breath-taking scenery, warm hospitality, world-class cuisine and the finest wines all combine to create lasting memories. Some of the spectacular vineyards that cover the mountain slopes date back more than 300 years to when the valley was first settled by the French Huguenots, who brought with them their age-old French wine and food culture. This is a valley rich in history centered around a picturesque village of friendly, welcoming people. Explore the beautiful Franschhoek Valley and visit a number of fantastic wineries where you will indulge in wine, brandy, cheese or chocolate tastings. A cellar tour and a culinary course at one of Franschhoek's best known restaurants will expose the passion behind the creation of exceptional wines and cuisine, and inspire you to take your own culinary efforts to another level. A different restaurant will be visited for each of the lunches and dinners while in the valley, highlighting different types and styles of cuisine.

#### Mont Rochelle

Mont Rochelle is a stunning 22-bedroom hotel and vineyard set on 39 hectares (about 100 acres) of prime land in the picturesque Franschhoek Valley. There are two restaurants, a cosy bar, a spa, a gym and a heated outdoor pool. [Mont Rochelle Website](#)

## **Sabi Sand Game Reserve, southern Greater Kruger – Singita Boulders Lodge – 3 Nights**




### The Greater Kruger

The Kruger National Park is the second oldest National Park in the world and arguably the best-known of Africa's great wildlife sanctuaries. At 6 million acres, the Park is one of the largest in the world and has the greatest diversity of fauna and flora of any African park. A unique feature of the Kruger National Park is the inclusion (no physical barrier) along the western border of 650 000 acres of private conservation land into a mega-park called 'Greater Kruger'. Many of Africa's finest lodges are to be found in this private section which is divided into separately managed reserves, one of which is the famous Sabi Sand Reserve comprising 160 000 acres of prime wildlife land where your lodge is situated. The area is renowned for its big game viewing and the totally open vehicles, ability to follow big game off-road, night drives with spotlight to search for nocturnal species, and the contributory skills of some of the best wildlife trackers on the continent will make for a thrilling safari.

### Singita Boulders Lodge

Located in the Sabi Sand Game Reserve on the south-western border of the Park, 12 magnificent and spacious suites all overlook the perennial Sand River. Suites all feature an en-suite bathroom and shower, outside shower, private heated swimming pool, double-sided fireplace, private lounge and game-viewing deck. The name Boulders was inspired by an enormous boulder located at the spot where the wine cellar was to be built but rather than removing it, a simple decision was made to build the cellar around the boulder! Singita has one of the finest private wine collections on the continent and this underground cellar will showcase some of South Africa's finest wines to be enjoyed at a wine tasting and as an accompaniment to superb meals, including a wine paired multi-course dinner. ## **Malilangwe Game Reserve – Singita Pamushana Lodge – 3 Nights**

**Included:** All meals, local beverages, laundry service, daily activities, private guide & private vehicle\* (\*with private tour option).

### Malilangwe Game Reserve

In 1994, the not-for-profit Malilangwe Trust was established as a result of the largest single donor investment ever in Zimbabwe, in order to purchase, protect, and manage the extraordinary wilderness area next to the Gonarezhou National Park in southeastern Zimbabwe. Singita Pamushana Lodge is the ecotourism arm of this 130,000 acre reserve, and its role is to help foster the sustainability of the wildlife and broader ecology, while enabling guests to share the magic of the lodge and the Malilangwe Wildlife Reserve. Malilangwe remains virtually untouched by humankind. The area is home to hundreds of baobab trees and an unrivalled gathering of birds with more than 500 species, including many raptors. The full selection of bigger game species is to be found in the rolling savannah while the dam below the lodge is a magnet for wildlife.

### Singita Pamushana Lodge

This exclusive lodge comprises just 4 single suites and 3 multi-roomed family villas. Activities include game drives, bushwalks, mountain biking, community visits, trips to rock art sites, fishing and boat cruises on the dam. Singita is widely considered to be one of the leading lodge brands in Africa and has set new standards for the food and wine experience offered at remote wildlife lodges.
