

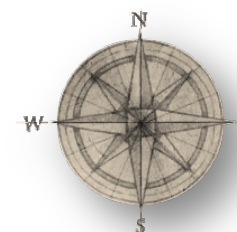
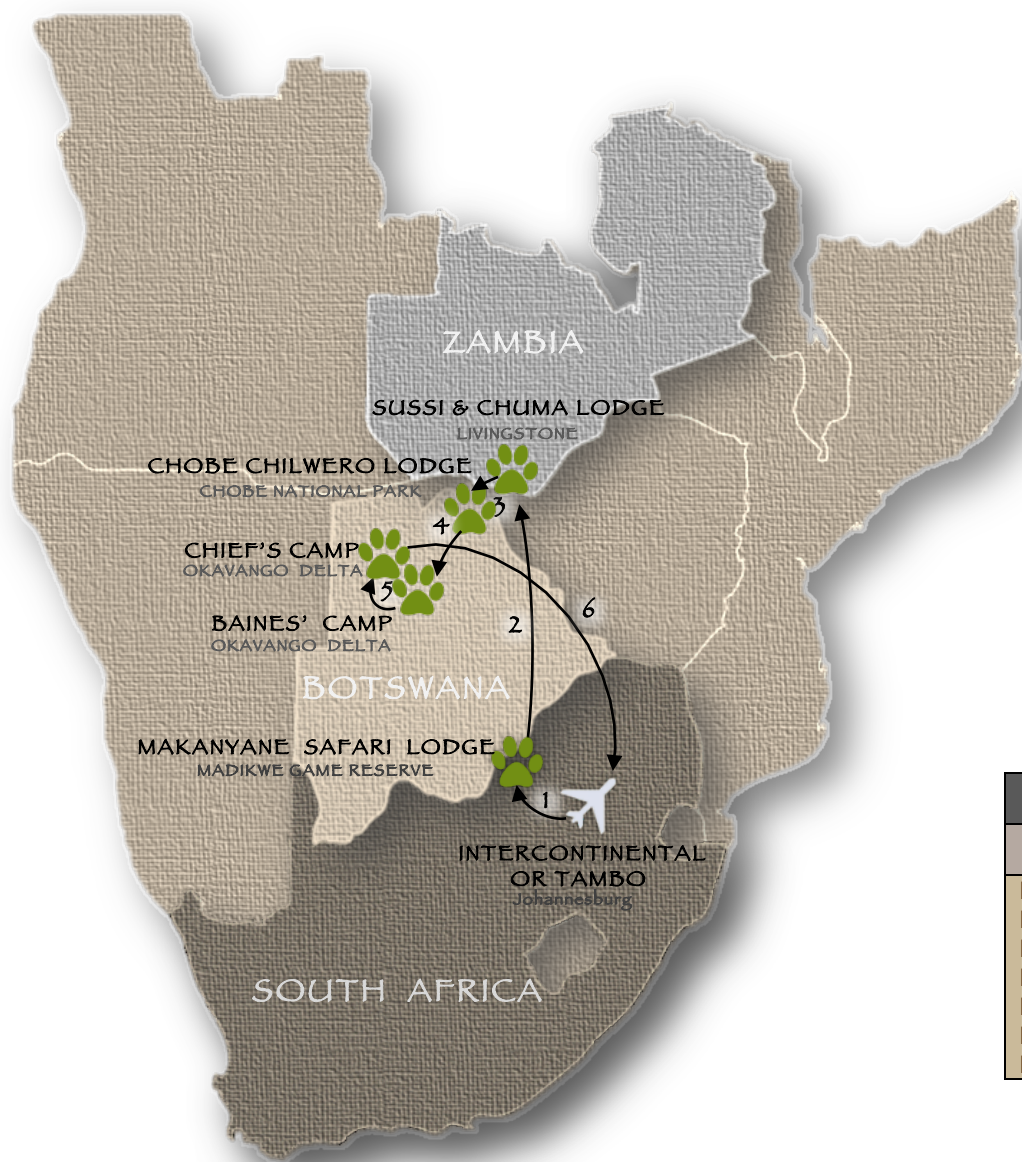

Johannesburg

Johannesburg is the second largest city in Africa. Known as the greatest gold-mining area on earth, this vibrant city is not just an industrial giant; it is the heart of the country's economy. From traditional 'muti' (medicine) shops to exclusive boutiques in upmarket malls, theatres, museums, cultural villages, restaurants, beautiful walks in indigenous gardens and more, Johannesburg is a diverse cultural melting pot, deserving of its name of 'iGoli' or 'City of Gold'.

InterContinental O.R. Tambo Airport Hotel

This 5-star hotel is conveniently situated at the airport hub and is only a 5-minute walk from the arrivals hall. The well-appointed rooms are tastefully decorated with subtle influences of Africa. 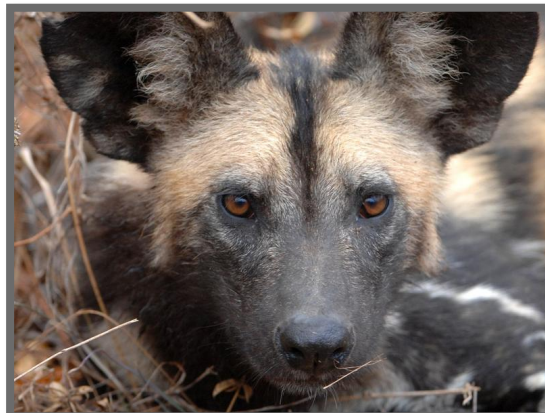
Madikwe Game Reserve – Makanyane Safari Lodge – 2 Nights

Madikwe Game Reserve

The malaria free 150 000 acre (75 000 ha) Madikwe Game Reserve is situated in the North West Province of South Africa. It is bordered by Botswana in the north, the Dwaarsberg Mountains to the south and the Marico River to the east. The diverse habitat in the reserve ranges from acacia thickets to more open savannah and riverine bush ensuring a unique combination of mammal and bird species. Madikwe offers the Big Five and is considered one of the best places on the continent to see African wild dog – the second most endangered carnivore in Africa. Sightings of lion, elephant, buffalo and rhino are also frequent and off-road driving is permitted to get close-up views of the cats. Night drives with spotlights in search of nocturnal species are also permitted.

Makanyane Safari Lodge is a luxurious and intimate lodge set in a private concession in the Madikwe Game Reserve. Accommodation consists of eight stunning glass-fronted suites, hidden in lush riverine woodland and offering uninterrupted views over the tranquil Marico River. Each air-conditioned suite features a private sun deck, outside lounge, en-suite bathroom with shower, roll top bath and a secluded outside shower. The suites also offer fireplaces, tea and coffee making facilities, a safe and a minibar. Lodge facilities include a lounge area with two rock fireplaces, an elegant dining room, a vast wooden deck area, curio shop, library, a wine cellar, a spa, an air-conditioned gym and a heated infinity-edge swimming pool. 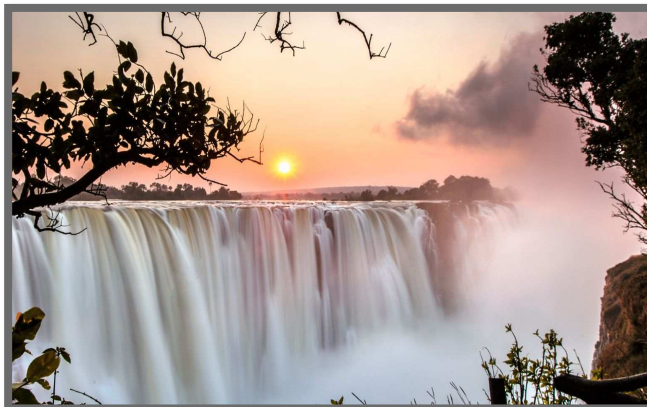
Livingstone and Mosi-oa-Tunya National Park

The town of Livingstone has become Zambia's tourist capital. Livingstone is situated a short distance from Victoria Falls, the largest single waterfall in the world by volume in peak flood and a member of the old Seven Natural Wonders of the World. Columns of spray can be seen for many miles as 750 000 tons of water plummet over the edge every minute at the height of flood season. The Falls are 1 mile (1,5 km) wide and average 330 feet (100 m) high. Mosi-oa-Tunya National Park abuts the town and is home to a wide diversity of animals including the country's only white rhino. Most visitors are drawn to Livingstone for Victoria Falls, but the town has attractions of its own, most notably an interesting colonial history combined with a very African ambience.

Sussi & Chuma Lodge

This beautiful lodge comprises 12 luxury 'tree-houses' built into the canopy of majestic ebony trees lining the riverbank, 12 km (7.5 mi) upstream of Victoria Falls. The air-conditioned rooms all with their own private viewing deck boast superb views over the white waters of the Zambezi. The main lodge commands prime position overlooking a magnificent stretch of rapids and comprises a lounge, bar, dining room, pool, spa and numerous decks overlooking the river.

Chobe National Park – Chobe Chilwero Lodge – 2 Nights

Chobe National Park

This National Park was proclaimed in 1967 and its 2,75 million acres (1,1 million ha) is home to arguably the largest single elephant population in Africa (65 000) along with a host of other herbivores and carnivores. The habitat is predominantly broad-leaved woodland with most of the game concentrating along the Chobe River – itself a tributary of the Zambezi – in the north of the park. This river forms the international boundary with Namibia and its confluence with the Zambezi a few miles downstream of the town of Kasane is unique in being the meeting point of four countries – Botswana, Namibia, Zambia and Zimbabwe. Game-viewing activities include game drives, boat trips and fishing (the latter in Namibian waters).

Chobe Chilwero Lodge

Sitting above the Chobe River, this small 'boutique lodge' comprises just 15 spacious chalets and offers unparalleled panoramic views across the islands and floodplains. Each chalet features a private garden with a hammock as well as en-suite facilities that include a bath, and indoor and outdoor showers. The public areas offer extensive indoor and outdoor dining areas, a library with satellite television, a curio shop, swimming pool and spa. [Chobe Chilwero Lodge Website](#)

Baines' Camp

Set in a grove of trees and surrounded by papyrus beds, Sanctuary Baines' Camp is located in a private concession bordering the Moremi Game Reserve. This intimate camp is raised above the permanent water of the Boro River while wooden walkways connect the main areas and luxury rooms. The five elevated suites are opulent and luxurious, with en-suite facilities and four-poster beds. Should you wish, your bed can be wheeled out onto the private wooden deck for a night under the stars, overlooking the shimmering waters of the Boro River. Or take an indulgent soak under the stars in a lavish bathtub on your own private viewing deck. The main areas include a lounge and dining area, small library and swimming pool. Chief's Camp

Named after Chief Moremi, Sanctuary Chief's Camp is located in the world-renowned Moremi Game Reserve. Chief's Island is one of the many islands created by the seasonal floodwaters of the Okavango Delta and is well-known for some of the finest game viewing in Southern Africa. The ten luxury thatch and tented bush suites are nestled in a jackalberry and sausage tree woodland, each boasting their own private dining area, outside seating area, plunge pool, and beautiful bathrooms which offer a spacious outdoor shower and a large bath tub. The main area houses a bar area, orientation room, fitness centre, swimming pool, sitting room, curio shop, library, reception and both indoor and outdoor dining areas. [Chief's Camp Website](#)
